Digital transformation in adult education for inclusive online training

ABOUT THE PROJECT

COVID-19 crisis has resulted in a significant increase in online learning by adults, however, adult educators across Europe were plunged into the situation to pursue the training that had started as classroom-based to online, with non or very little professional training for this digital transformation.

The project aims to support adult education organisations and adult educators in the pathway for digital transformation to high-quality inclusive online training by developing the Learning Hub "Digital Transformation".



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Five project results will be produced:

- **e-Toolkit “Quality assurance for digital transformation to high-quality inclusive online training in adult education organisation”** – it consists of three interconnected online learning tools for adult education organisations to implement their digital transformation plans.
- **Assessment Tool with micro-credential “Digital Transformator”** for tracking the progress of adult learners (adult educators- practitioners) in the learning process for digital transformation from face-to-face training to open online training.
- **OOC “Developing adult educators digital competence for pedagogical activities towards for digital transformation to high-quality inclusive online training”** consists of 7 modules and includes learning material for developing four main digital competences: digital resources; teaching and learning; assessment; empowering learners for digital education.
- **e-Guide: Facilitation of the Learning Hub “Digital transformation to high-quality online training”** consists of 4 interconnected supporting guidelines for adult educators-facilitators to provide training for adult educators-practitioners on digital transformation.
- **Short Online course (SOC) “Gender equality in the labour market”** for adult learners, especially women, to empower them to participate equally with men in the labour market and overcome gender-based stereotypes.



The online training for improving adult educators-practitioners digital competences is based on the European Framework for the Digital Competence of Educators and includes the modules for developing four digital competences: digital resources; teaching and learning; assessment; empowering learners.
